Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid to the State of **Arunachal Pradesh** under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme '**Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States**'.

Sir,

In supersession of earlier sanction orders of even number dated 25.10.2018 and 12.11.2018, I am directed to convey sanction of the President of India to incur an expenditure not exceeding to **Rs. 1400.00 Lakh (Rupees Fourteen Crore only)** towards partial fulfillment of 1st installment for establishment of 5 new ITIs at Namsai, East Kameng, Kurung Kumey, Tawang and West Siang districts to the society "**Arunachal Pradesh Skill Development Society**" in the State of **Arunachal Pradesh** under the Scheme "**Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States**" as detailed below:-

2. The accounts of all grantee institution or organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so. All other terms and conditions for release of funds for the Project will remain unchanged.

3. The release of Rs. 1400.00 Lakh (Rupees Fourteen Crore only) grant-in-aid for creation of capital assets to "**Arunachal Pradesh Skill Development Society**" under the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i. The fund sanctioned is of Non-Recurring nature and shall be spend for Non-Recurring purposes only.
- ii. Utilisation Certificate should be submitted online only through EAT module of PFMS, component wise, year wise expenditure statement may be furnished immediately after utilisation.
- iii. The next installment of the fund would be released as per provision of GFR on the basis of actual expenditure incurred, terms and conditions stated in Implementation Manual and utilisation certificate furnished by the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
- iv. The Sanction is valid upto one year from the date of issue.
- v. All the purchases will be made in accordance with the State Govt. norms.
- vi. Utilization of fund will be assessed by monthly progress report, field visits, photograph/ videos etc.
- vii. Sanction of grant is strictly restricted to the admissibility as per the SFC. Any expenditure beyond the admissibility as per SFC to be arranged by any other sources.
- viii. A separate maintenance contract including annual white wash of building, repairs of all electrical nature, plumbing as required, maintenance of lawns, gardening, sports facilities etc. may be made part of the construction contract.
- ix. Introduction of new trades must be with a view to fulfilling unmet needs and must be based on surveys/feedback showing demand for these trades.

- x. Given the low enrolment of women in ITIs, it may be ensured that trades popular with women candidates are also included. Other specific efforts to be made to increase enrolment, including publicity drives, education fairs in campuses etc.
- xi. Specific physical and financial mile-stones with corresponding half-yearly targets for their implementation may be provided. In the event of any slippage from adherence of these specific target at the end of every six months, monitoring division apprised of the reasons for slippage along with strategy to achieve the targets.
- xii. Accessibility features must be provided in all new constructions. Old buildings must be retrofitted. This must be adhered to irrespective of the presence/ absence of any student with disabilities.
- xiii. Possibility of disbursal linked indicators may be explored for new hostels.
- xiv. A compulsory module in entrepreneurship may be added to all existing courses to provide capacity building for self-employment.
- xv. Training / attachment with industry may be made essential.

4. The "Arunachal Pradesh Skill Development Society" is required to utilize the aid as per the guidelines of the Scheme and furnish physical & financial progress report as per the format prescribed in Implementation Manual of the Scheme or as per amended formats time to time.

5. The sanction relates to expenditure and is in accordance with the aid appraised by the appropriate appraisal forum Standing Finance Committee (SFC) and approved by the appropriate approval authority in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Plan Finance- II Division OM NO.1(3)/PF-II/2001 dt1.4.2010.

6. The expenditure is debit-able to the Major Heads 2230.03.102.15.05.35- Grants for creation of capital assets.

7. Section Officer (Cash Section)/ Drawing and Disbursing Officer, DGT, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship will draw the amount sanctioned vide para 1 above for Rs.1400.00 Lakh and pay Rs.1400.00 Lakh to the below mentioned society by transferring electronically to the bank account of the society. The details of the society are given below:
