Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid to the society "Society for Entrepreneurship Development" formed for implementation the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States and Sikkim' in the state of Tripura.

I am directed to convey sanction of the President of India to incur an expenditure not exceeding to **Rs. 517.25 lakh (Rupees Five Crore Seventeen Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only)** towards establishment of 3 new ITIs and final installment for Upgradation in one ITI and Supplementing Deficient Infrastructure in one ITI in the State of Tripura under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States and Sikkim" as detailed below:-

2. Further the above sanction is subjected to the following conditions:

- The Sanction is valid upto one year from the date of issue.
- All the purchases will be made in accordance with the State Govt. norms.
- Utilization of fund will be assessed by monthly progress report, field visits, photograph/ videos etc.
- Subsequent release of funds will be made after sufficient utilization of fund and sending Utilization Certificate as per format.

3. The Society is required to utilize the aid as per the guidelines of the Scheme and furnish physical & financial progress report as per the format prescribed in Implementation Manual of the Scheme.

4. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the aid appraised by the appropriate appraisal forum Standing Finance Committee (SFC) and approved by the appropriate approval authority in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, No.24(35)/PF-II/2012 dt29-08-2014.

5. The expenditure is debit-able to the Major Head 3601-Grants in Aid to State Government, 04- Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes, 321- Training Grants- Training of Craftsmen and Supervisors, 03 – Others Schemes, 07- Skill Development Initiative/Skill Development (Merged), 35- Grant-in-aid for creation of capital assets.

6. The amount of **Rs.517.25 lakh (Rupees Five Crore Seventeen Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only)** may be transferred to Government of Tripura through Reserve Bank of India as per procedure laid down by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide O.M. No. F-II(45/76/SC) dated 22-02-1977.


7. An original copy of UC as per form 19A of GFR along with a copy of UC received from the State of Tripura forwarded to the Principal Accounts office.
