Subject: Option for revision of courses proposed to be introduced in ITIs under STRIVE

Sir/Madam,

Multiple requests have been received from States/UTs during capacity building workshops to allow change in list of proposed courses submitted in ISP by ITIs (Govt. and Private). States believe that change in proposed courses is necessary to provide industry relevant training to the students.

2. NPIU has accepted the request for revision of courses from States. However, total funding allocated to the ITI under STRIVE will not change. Accordingly, if ITIs (Govt. or Private) in a State/UT desire to change the list of proposed courses, then states are required to share with NPIU the following documents through the link: <https://forms.gle/ofeJEJ7oXNFDiADBA> latest by 30th Jan 2020:

- a. A state-level consolidated ITI-wise list of revised proposed trades/courses
- b. SSC recommendation and approval for change in proposed trades/courses (as per provisions of STRIVE OM) along with the minutes of meeting for the same.
- c. If ITI is changing even one proposed trade/course, then the full list of proposed trades/courses for that ITI need to be provided.

3. In view of the above, states are requested to disseminate the above information to all STRIVE selected ITIs. If the above mentioned documents (along with SSC approval) are not shared by 30th Jan 2020, then the original proposed list of courses submitted by ITI in ISP will be considered as final.
