2. Further the above sanction is subject to the following conditions:


- For one District, the maximum number of trainees for Long Term training, Short Term training and Instructor training is 30, 120 and 10, respectively.
- Stipend will be paid @ Rs. 3500/- per month per trainee to all the trainees.

- Travelling allowance to be paid to the trainees subject to the submission of Rail Ticket (2<sup>nd</sup> class sleeper or lower) and/or Bus Ticket for shortest route of journey to the Training Institute from nearest rail station / bus stop to home address and return for one to & fro journey only subject to a limit of Rs. 1600/-.
  - Training fee to be paid to the institutes providing training to the youth under the scheme maximum @ Rs. 100/- per month per trainee for Long Term training and Instructor training.
  - Training fee to be paid to the institutes providing training to the youth under the scheme maximum @ Rs. 5000/- per trainee (lump sum) for Short Term training.
  - Contingencies to be paid to the Institutes providing training to the youth under the scheme maximum @ 10% of total Training Fee.
  - Subsequent release of fund will be made only after receipt of Utilisation Certificate (UC) from the State Government and sufficient utilisation of fund, subject to availability of fund.
  - Sanction of grant is strictly restricted to the admissibility as per the decisions arrived in the meeting of Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC).
3. The State of West Bengal is required to utilise the aid as per the guidelines of the scheme and furnish physical and financial progress reports as per the formats prescribed in the Implementation manual.
4. The sanction relates to the Plan expenditure and is in accordance with the aid appraised by the appropriate appraisal forum Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) and approved by the appropriate approval authority in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Plan Finance-II Division OM No. 1(3)/PF-II/2001 dt. 01.04.2011.
