Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid to the State of Meghalaya under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme '**Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States**'.

Sir,

I am directed to convey sanction of the President to incur expenditure not exceeding **Rs.5,18,50,000/- (Rupees Five Crore Eighteen Lakh and Fifty Thousand only)** towards subsequent installment for Upgradation of 4 exiting ITIs (i.e. Sohra, Resubelpara, Nongstoin and Nongpoh) & Supplementing Deficient Infrastructure in 4 existing ITIs (i.e. Sohra, Resubelpara, Nongstoin and Nongpoh) and Establishment of One (1) new ITI at Mawkyrwat to the State of **Meghalaya** under the Scheme "**Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States**" as detailed below:-

2. The accounts of all grantee institution or organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so. All other terms and conditions for release of funds for the Project will remain unchanged.

3. The release of **Rs.5,18,50,000/- (Rupees Five Crore Eighteen Lakh and Fifty Thousand only)** as Upgradation of 4 exiting ITIs & Supplementing Deficient Infrastructure in 4 existing ITIs and Establishment of One (1) new ITI to the State of **Meghalaya** is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- The fund sanctioned is of non -Recurring nature and shall be spent for non-Recurring purposes only.
- Utilisation Certificate should be submitted online only through EAT module of PFMS, component wise, year wise expenditure statement may be furnished immediately after utilisation.
- The next installment of the funds would be released as per the provision of GFRs 2017 on the basis of actual expenditure incurred, terms and conditions as stipulated in the Implementation Manual of the Scheme and the utilisation certificates forwarded by the State Government of Meghalaya.
- The sanction is valid up to the project completion period.
- All the procurements should be made through Government e marketplace(GeM) and in case of non availability of the item on GeM portal , may be procured in accordance with the State Govt. norms of procurement.

- vi. Utilization of funds will be monitored by monthly progress reports, field visits of the relevant locations , video/photographs etc.
- vii. Sanction of grant is strictly restricted to the admissibility and provisions as per the Standing Finance Committee (SFC) of the scheme. Any expenditure beyond the admissibility in terms of SFC, is to be arranged by other sources.
- viii. A separate maintenance contract including annual whitewash of building, repairs of all electrical nature, plumbing as required, maintenance of lawns, gardening, sports facilities etc., may be made part of the construction contract.
- ix. Introduction of new trades must be with a view of fulfilling unmet needs and must be based on surveys/feedback showing demand for these trades.
- x. Specific physical financial milestone with corresponding half yearly targets for their implementation may be provided. In the event of any slippage from adherence of these specific target at the end of every six months, Monitoring Division be apprised of the reasons for slippage along with strategy to achieve the targets.
- xi. Persons with Disability(PwD) accessibility features must be provided in all new construction. Old building must be retrofitted. This must be adhered to irrespective of the presence/ absence of any student with disabilities.
- xii. Possibility of disbursal linked indicators may be explored for new hostels.
- xiii. Training/ attachment with industry may be explored.

4. The State of **Meghalaya** is required to utilize the aid as per the guidelines of the Scheme and furnish physical & financial progress report as per the format prescribed in Implementation Manual of the Scheme.

5. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the aid appraised by the appropriate appraisal forum Standing Finance Committee (SFC) and approved by the appropriate approval authority in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Plan Finance- II Division OM NO.1(3)/PF-II/2001 dt1.4.2010.

6. The expenditure is debit-able to the Major Head 3601.06.101.36.07.35-Grants for creation of capital assets.

7. An amount of **Rs.5,18,50,000/- (Rupees Five Crore Eighteen Lakh and Fifty Thousand only)** may be transferred to the **Government of Meghalaya** through Reserve Bank of India as per procedure laid down by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide O.M. No F-II(45/76/SC) dated 22-09-1977.


