Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid to the Society "Vocational Training Projects Implementation Society of Sikkim"- formed by Government of Sikkim to implement the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States and Sikkim'.

Sir,

You are directed to convey sanction of the President of India to incur an expenditure not exceeding to **Rs.202.07 Lakh (Rupees Two Crore Two Lakh and Seven Thousand only)** towards subsequent installment for Supplementing Deficient Infrastructure of existing ITIs at Namchi, Rangpo and Gyashiling in the State of Sikkim to the Society "Vocational Training Projects Implementation Society of Sikkim" formed for implementation of the scheme in the State of Sikkim under the Scheme "Enhancing Skill Development infrastructure in NE States" as detailed below:-

2. The accounts of all grantee institution or organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so. All other terms and conditions for release of funds for the Project will remain unchanged.

3. The release of Rs.202.07 Lakh (Rupees Two Crore Two Lakh and Seven Thousand only) as grants for Supplementing Deficient Infrastructure of existing ITIs at Namchi, Rangpo and Gyashiling in the State of Sikkim to "Vocational Training Projects Implementation Society of Sikkim" formed for implementation of the scheme under the State Government of Sikkim is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i. Utilisation Certificate should be submitted online only through EAT module of PFMS, component wise, year wise expenditure statement may be furnished immediately after utilisation.
- ii. The next installment, if any, of the fund would be released after receipt of UC as per provision in form 12C in GFR 2017 on the basis of actual expenditure incurred, terms and conditions stated in Implementation Manual and utilisation certificate furnished by the State Government of Sikkim.
- iii. The Sanction is valid upto one year from the date of issue.
- iv. All the purchases will be made in accordance with the State Govt. norms.
- v. Utilization of fund will be assessed by monthly progress report, field visits, photograph/ videos etc.
- vi. Sanction of grant is strictly restricted to the admissibility as per the SFC. Any expenditure beyond the admissibility as per SFC to be arranged by any other sources.
- vii. A separate maintenance contract including annual white wash of building, repairs of all electrical nature, plumbing as required, maintenance of lawns, gardening, sports facilities etc. may be made part of the construction contract.
- viii. Specific efforts to be made to increase enrolment of women, including publicity drives, education fairs in campuses etc.

- ix. Specific physical and financial mile stones with corresponding half-yearly targets for their implementation may be provided. In the event of any slippage from adherence of these specific target at the end of every six months, monitoring division apprised of the reasons for slippage along with strategy to achieve the targets.
- x. Accessibility features must be provided in all new constructions. Old buildings must be retrofitted. This must be adhered to irrespective of the presence/ absence of any student with disabilities.
- xi. Possibility of disbursal linked indicators may be explored for new hostels.
- xii. A compulsory module in entrepreneurship may be added to all existing courses to provide capacity building for self-employment.
- xiii. Training / attachment with industry may be made essential.

4. The "Vocational Training Projects Implementation Society of Sikkim" is required to utilize the aid as per the guidelines of the Scheme and furnish physical & financial progress report as per the format prescribed in Implementation Manual of the Scheme.

5. The sanction relates to Expenditure and is in accordance with the aid appraised by the appropriate appraisal forum Standing Finance Committee (SFC) and approved by the appropriate approval authority in terms of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Plan Finance- II Division OM NO.1(3)/PF-II/2001 dated 14.2.2010.

6. The expenditure is debit-able to the Major Head 2230.03.102.15.12.35- Grants for creation of capital assets.

7. Section Officer (Cash Section)/ Drawing and Disbursing Officer, DGT, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship will draw the amount sanctioned vide para 1 above for Rs.202.07 Lakh and pay Rs.202.07 Lakh to the below mentioned society by transferring electronically to the bank account of the society. The details of the society are given below:


